Our **Legacy Society** honors the generosity of those who make legacy gifts to our SVdP Parish and to inspire others to do the same.

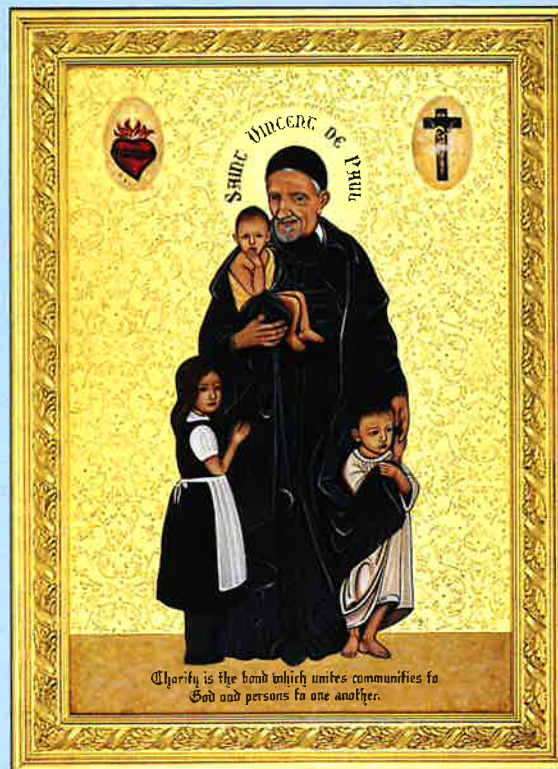

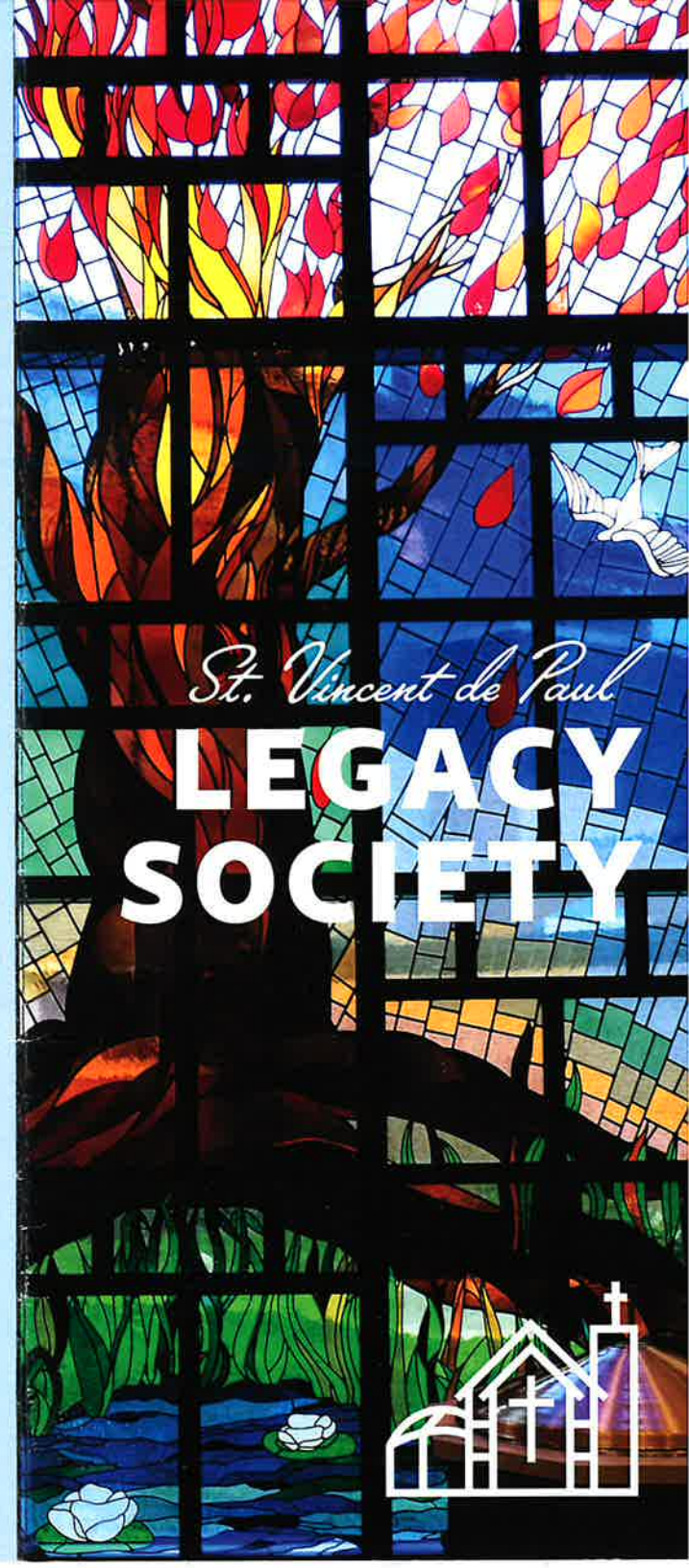
